AIPAC works with both Democratic and Republican political leaders to enact public policy that strengthens the vital U.S.-Israel relationship. With the support of its members nationwide, AIPAC has worked with Congress and the Executive Branch on numerous critical initiatives—from securing vital foreign aid for Israel to passing legislation.

AJC works to promote pluralistic and democratic societies where all minorities are protected. Their key areas of focus are combating anti-Semitism and all forms of bigotry, supporting Israel's quest for peace and security, advocating for energy independence, and strengthening Jewish life.
